Make a Clock




Directions:

- If you're going to allow student to color their clock, I recommend letting them do that first.
- Once they color, have them cut out their clock and pieces.
- Students glue the numbers into the correct spots on the clock.
- Next, have students attach a brass fastener in the black dot on their clock hands and through the black dot in the center of the clock to create moving hands.

Teacher Directions:


Give student a paperclip to use as a spinner for the "Spin It" clock sheet. I personally print it on a piece of color paper and laminate it first for durability. You could also attach the paperclip with a brass fastener if you'd like. I recommend printing the dice on thick paper before you cut and assemble.


Have students spin the spinner then roll the dice to figure out the time. The spinner figures out the hour and the dice figures out the minutes (:00 or :30). They find the time they made on their sheet and color in the football with that time. I included 3 different pages so students can have different ones. You could make it a fun game where they roll/spin and color on their recording sheet, racing a partner. If the spot is already colored in, they can't color in anything else — and the first person to color in all of their footballs wins!


Differentiation: I included a very plain digital time version for easily distracted students.


There is also a "Spinnin' Time" version for when you are only practicing time to the hour where students only spin to figure out the time and color in their footballs.




Teacher Directions:

This is a simple clock mat for students to practice drawing and telling time. It is perfect for small groups or centers.

Laminate it or put it in a sheet protector so that students can write on it with a dry erase marker.

For small group, tell students a time and have them draw it on the clock. Then, have them write it in digital form below.

For more of a center activity, have students choose a time strip and draw it on their clock then write it below or vice versa. They can work on JUST hour, half-hour, or written form or mix them for more of a challenge.


Teacher Directions:

There are 2 different centers here:

- 1) Matching 12 clocks that show the time to the hour
- 2) Matching 12 clocks that show the time to the half hour

Students simply match the clocks to the correct time and then record it on their recording sheets by drawing the time on the blank clock and writing the time underneath.

There are 3 different levels of recording sheets — one with 12 blank clocks to use all of the cards (recommended) and 2 easier versions for students who struggle with only 6 clocks or 4 clocks. To make this activity more difficult, mix 12 of the hour / half hour clocks together for mixed practice. To make this activity even harder, mix all 24 of the clocks/cards together and copy the 12-clock recording sheet back to back to combine both centers.




































Teacher Directions:

I recommend laminating the puzzles before cutting them out to make them more durable.

Have students match the 3 parts of each puzzle and then copy it onto their recording sheet.

I have included a to-the-hour center and a to-the-half-hour center. You can have students do them separately or mix them up for a challenge. The recording sheet has 6 puzzles on it so I recommend copying it back to back to do 12 puzzles at a time; however, only do 6 if that's all your students can handle.




This center is great for a large pocket chart if you have one.


Have students sort each activity under about how long it will take. Of course they're not exact measurements of how long the activity would take but tell students to sort based on about how long they'd take. I recommend acting some actions out as an example before having them do the center independently. For example, act out brushing your teeth for 1 second and say, "Would that clean your teeth?" or explain how an hour is like 2 T.V. shows and ask if they'd brush your teeth that loooong? Act a little silly! They'll love it!


I recommend having students sort 2 periods of time (minute vs. hour) at a time but you can throw all 3 at the same time as well for more of a challenge. I included a recording sheet for all possibilities. Have students simply write the activities under the correct column or even make up their own!

























































































Race to Noon

Teacher Directions:

This is a simple but fun game. Give each student that is playing a small ball of clay/dough to roll like a snake to make their clock hand. It's best if they each get their own mat so their hands don't cross. Have them start with pointing their dough clock hand at midnight (12).
