

ELKS 2025 SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Elks National Foundation (ENF) Most Valuable Student (MVS) Scholarships (500):

- Five hundred (500) scholarships are available ranging from \$1,000 to \$7,500 per year
- Scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 units per semester)
- Scholarships will be based upon academics, demonstrated leadership and financial need
- Current high school seniors who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply
- Applicants **DO NOT** have to be related to a member of the Elks
- Female and male students compete separately
- Applications are due November 12, 2024. Select the Oak Island Elks Lodge #2769 as the sponsoring lodge
